It is a free project and it fits perfectly into the information literacy standards we cover.

The exciting part is that students throughout the district and around the world will be reading the same books during the same week. We will use technology tools such as Padlet and Book Creator to facilitate these connections and conversations.

We are very excited to connect with others, especially since more than 600,000 students are already signed up to participate. This project will allow for our students to use multimedia tools in meaningful ways, as well as raise awareness about other cultures, all the while listening to a fantastic read aloud.
